Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1267 (1999)

Letter dated 25 April 2002 from the Permanent Representative of the Netherlands to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of the Kingdom of the Netherlands to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1267 (1999) and, with reference to paragraph 6 of Security Council resolution 1390 (2002), has the honour to report upon the implementation of resolution 1390 (2002) to the Committee.

In the Netherlands measures ensuing from Security Council resolutions are in general implemented via European Union regulations, which are directly applicable in the Netherlands. We expect the European Union regulation implementing resolution 1390 (2002) to be adopted soon. Till the adoption of that regulation the Netherlands have in place legislation based upon Security Council resolutions 1267 (1999) and 1333 (2000) regarding the persons and entities listed under those resolutions. Information with regard to the implementation of resolutions 1267 (1999) and 1333 (2000) has already been submitted to the Counter-Terrorism Committee in the reports of the Netherlands (S/2001/1264) and the European Union (S/2001/1297).

After the adoption of the European Union regulation implementing resolution 1390 (2002), a full report in accordance with the provided guidance will be submitted to the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1267 (1999).
