Draft report

I. Introduction

- 1. The Preparatory Committee for the Special Session of the General Assembly on Children held a resumed third session on 2 May 2002. It held one meeting, under the Chairmanship of Ambassador Patricia Durrant (Jamaica), to consider item 6 of its agenda, "Consideration of the outcome of the special session".
- 2. During the meeting, the Committee elected Ambassador Iftekhar Chowdhury (Bangladesh) by acclamation as its Vice-Chairman.
- 3. At the same meeting, the Committee further considered the draft outcome document entitled "A world fit for children" (A/AC.256/CRP.6/Rev.5) and decided to transmit it to the General Assembly at its twenty-seventh special session for further consideration (see chap. II, para. 5).
- 4. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted its report (A/AC.256/L.16), as orally amended.

II. Decision of the Committee

5. The Committee adopted the following decision:

At the 1st meeting of the resumed third session, or 2 May 2002, the Preparatory Committee for the Special Session of the General Assembly on Children decided to transmit to the General Assembly at its twenty-seventh special session the text of the draft outcome document entitled "A world fit for children", which is contained in the annex.
