CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS SUBMITTED BY STATES PARTIES UNDER ARTICLE 19 OF THE CONVENTION

Third periodic reports of States parties due in 2002

Note by the Secretary-General

- 1. In accordance with article 19, paragraph 1, of the Convention against Torture and Other Cruel, Inhuman or Degrading Treatment or Punishment, the States parties shall submit to the Committee against Torture, through the Secretary-General of the United Nations, reports on the measures they have taken to give effect to their undertakings under the Convention, within one year after the entry into force of the Convention for the State party concerned. Thereafter the States parties shall submit supplementary reports every four years on any new measures taken and such other reports as the Committee may request.
- 2. Accordingly, second supplementary (third periodic) reports under article 19, paragraph 1, of the Convention are due in 2002 from eight States parties, on the following dates:

Antigua and Barbuda: 17 August 2002

Armenia: 12 October 2002 Burundi: 19 March 2002 Costa Rica: 10 December 2002 Mauritius: 7 January 2002 Morocco: 20 July 2002 Slovakia: 27 May 2002 Slovenia: 14 August 2002

3. The reports received from the States parties listed above will be issued as addenda to this document.
