QUESTION OF EAST TIMOR

Letter dated 2 October 1979 from the Permanent Representative of Indonesia to the United Nations addressed to the Chairman of the Fourth Committee

The position of the Indonesian delegation on the request for a hearing by petitioners on the question of East Timor is clearly reflected in our letter dated 1 October 1979, No. 942/POL/0429/79. 1/

In this context, with regard to the requests of Mr. Carlos Alfonso Henriques, 2/Mr. José Ramos-Horta 3/ and Ms. Elizabeth Traube 4/ to be heard as petitioners by the Committee, my delegation would like to express its strong opposition to the granting of such requests since it would serve no useful purpose.

I would like, therefore, to express my delegation's strong opposition to the participation of these petitioners in the deliberations of the Committee.

I would highly appreciate it if this letter could be circulated as a document of the Fourth Committee.
