LETTER FROM THE REPRESENTATIVE OF GREECE TO THE UNITED NATIONS
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL DATED 15 AUGUST 1947

15 August 1947

Sir,

With reference to the letter of 11 August 1947, reference number 80, addressed to you by the Representative of the Albanian People's Republic (document S/492), I have the honour, under instructions from my Government, to request you to be so good as to inform the Members of the Security Council that the two further allegations concerning fresh "provocations" committed by the Greek authorities on the Greek-Albanian frontier are as devoid of foundation as all previous charges made by the Albanian Government.

In this connection, I desire to repeat what I stated in my communication of 13 August 1947, reference number 3144, that the Greek Air Force does not possess three-engined aircraft.
