PERIODICITY AND DURATION OF GOVERNING COUNCIL SESSIONS

#### Supplement

#### COSTS ESTIMATES

- 1. The present Supplement contains cost estimates corresponding to the proposals set out for consideration by the Council in the addendum to the Executive Director's introductory report dealing with the periodicity and duration of Council sessions. The proposals relate to biennial or annual sessions of the Council, the informal consultations with Governments, and transitional arrangements.
- 2. The cost estimates take into account the fact that all six official languages, namely Arabic, Chinese, English, French, Russian and Spanish, will be used for all meetings. Furthermore, in addition to \$2,000 of actual travel costs for each interpreter, reviser, translator and typist the estimates provide for two days' salary and per diem during the travel in each direction, i.e. four days' salary and per diem in addition to the actual duration of the session. Lastly, salaries and per diem are calculated on a daily basis, weekends and holidays that fall within the duration of the session also have to be included in the estimates.

#### Notes

- 1/ If the annual intersessional informal consultations with Governments are continued, an additional \$164,600 will be required for the biennium (see estimate under section III).
- 2/ These estimates are based on the assumption that the customary informal consultations with heads of delegation will be held a day in advance of the session. If such consultations were to be held during rather than before the session (in keeping with the current practice), a saving of \$14,624 per session could be realized. It should be noted that no such consultations are envisaged in connexion with sessions of the Programme Committee.
- 3/ This estimate is based on the assumption that the 8 working days will include half a day for informal consultations among heads of delegation. If the consultations are to be held a day in advance of the formal opening of the session, an additional \$14,624 will be required. A further assumption is that the Council will concentrate in even years on programme matters and in odd years on Fund and administration matters.
