CABLE FROM THE MINISTER FOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF FINLAND  
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL  
DATED 19 SEPTEMBER 1947

Helsinki, Finland  
19 September 1947

Mr. Secretary-General

The treaty of peace with Finland having entered into force upon deposit of the ratifications with the government of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics on September 15th, I have the honour to request in the name of the government of Finland and with the consent of its parliament that Finland be admitted to membership in the United Nations and that this request be examined under paragraph 3 of rule 60 of the rules of procedure of the Security Council. I declare that Finland accepts the obligations of the Charter in accordance with Article 4 of the Charter.
