LETTER DATED 9 JUNE 1983 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF SPAIN  
TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have the honour to transmit to you the text of the telegram dated 8 June from His Excellency Mr. D. Fernando Morán, Minister for Foreign Affairs of Spain, addressed to the Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Republic of South Africa, pursuant to the provisions of operative paragraph 2 of Security Council resolution 533 (1983).

"Informed that death sentences Messrs. Anthony Tsotsobe, Johannes Shabangu and David Moise commuted, express my satisfaction at application of right of free pardon, earnestly request intervene with President so that, for humanitarian reasons, said clemency be extended to remaining persons sentenced, Messrs. Marcus Thabo Motaung, Jerry Semano Mosololi and Thelle Simon Mogoerane.

Furthermore, His Excellency Mr. D. Felipe González, President of the Government of Spain, has addressed to the South African Prime Minister an appeal in similar terms.
