LETTER FROM THE POLITICAL REPRESENTATIVE OF BULGARIA
TO THE UNITED STATES ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF
THE SECURITY COUNCIL DATED 23 OCTOBER 1947

October 23, 1947

Mr. President:

In June of this year I had the honour to submit in writing information to the effect that on the 13th of June, 1947, a company of approximately 200 Greek soldiers penetrated into Bulgarian territory in the vicinity of Svilengrad and after a brief skirmish retreated, kidnapping three Bulgarian citizens working in the fields.

My Government has instructed me to draw your attention to the fact that one of the kidnapped Bulgarian citizens, Mr. Peter Georgiev Angelov, was thrown in prison in Dedeagach where he subsequently died as a direct result of brutal maltreatment.
