REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-CENERAL ON THE CREDENTIALS OF REPRESENTATIVES TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL FOR THE DISCUSSION OF THE INDONESIAN QUESTION

Further to my reports of 1 and 11 August 1947 and following the decision of the Security Council at its hundred and eighty-first meeting on 12 August 1947, I have the honour to submit the following report on the credentials of the representative of the Republic of Indonesia, to the Security Council for the discussion of the Indonesian question.

I have examined credentials signed at Jogjakarta on 22 July 1947 by Mr. Soekarno, President of the Republic of Indonesia, appointing Dr. Sutan Sjahrir to the post of Ambassador-at-Large to represent the Republic of Indonesia in all matters, affairs and negotiations conducted with all foreign countries and governments and officers and officials connected therewith.

In my opinion, these credentials are in order.
