
REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO
THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL CONCERNING
THE CREDENTIALS OF REPRESENTATIVES TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL
FOR THE DISCUSSION OF THE INDONESIAN QUESTION.

Pursuant to Rule 15 of the Provisional Rules of Procedure of the Security Council I wish to report that I have examined a letter signed at New York on 19 September 1947 by Mr. Soetan Sjahrir, Ambassador-at-large of the Republic of Indonesia, empowering Mr. L. N. Palar to act for the Republic of Indonesia, and to appear before and correspond with the United Nations and its commissions.

In my opinion this letter constitutes provisional credentials adequate to enable Mr. Palar to participate in the discussion of the Indonesian Question in the Security Council.
