> IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROGRAMME FOR THE DECADE FOR ACTION TO COMBAT RACISM AND RACIAL DISCRIMINATION

PROPOSED PROGRAMME BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM 1980-1981

Administrative and financial implications of the draft resolution contained in document A/C.3/34/L.9

Statement submitted by the Secretary-General in accordance with rule 153 of the rules of procedure

1. The Third Committee, at its 23rd meeting held on 18 October 1979, adopted the draft resolution contained in document A/C.3/34/L.9. It had before it a statement of financial implications (A/C.3/34/L.14 and Corr.1).

2. Under operative paragraph 8 of the draft resolution contained in document A/C.3/34/L.9 the General Assembly would adopt a programme of activities for the second half of the Decade for Action to Combat Racism and Racial Discrimination. As part of this programme, contained in document A/C.3/34/L.10, the Secretary-General would be required to undertake the following activities during the biennium 1980-1981:

(a) The organization of regional seminars on an annual basis at the level of the regional commissions (para. 11);

(b) The organization in 1981 of a seminar to study the formulation of effective measures to prevent transnational corporations and other established interests from collaborating with the racist régimes of southern Africa (para. 17 (b));

(c) The undertaking of a study by the <u>Ad Hoc</u> Working Group of Experts on southern Africa on ways and means of implementing international instruments such as the International Convention on the Suppression and Punishment of the Crime of <u>Apartheid</u>, including the establishment of the international jurisdiction envisaged by the Convention (para. 20);

(d) The organization by the United Nations Institute for Training and Research (UNITAR) of an international colloquium in 1980 on the elimination of <u>apartheid</u>, racism and racial discrimination and the achievement of selfdetermination in international law, with special attention to the principles of non-discrimination and self-determination as peremptory norms of international law (para. 21);

(e) The undertaking of a study in 1981 on the links between the struggle against racism and the struggle for self-determination in southern Africa (para. 22);

(f) The undertaking of a study in 1981 in co-operation with the United Mations Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) and the World Health Organization (WHO) on the links between racial discrimination and inequalities in the fields of education, nutrition, health, housing and cultural development (para. 24).

3. The estimated expenditures which would arise from the implementation of the draft resolution, and the assumptions on which they are based, are as follows:

(a) Paragraph 11: Organization of regional seminars on an annual basis

The Secretary-General would propose to hold one regional seminar in Africa at Nairobi in July 1980 and another in Latin America in 1981 at a location to be determined. The related costs are estimated as follows:

Since this seminar was originally scheduled in 1979, additional appropriations were granted by the General Assembly at its thirty-third session and included in the programme budget for the biennium 1978-1979. The organizational phase for the holding of the seminar, however, will not be completed before the end of 1979. It is anticipated that the seminar will take place only in May 1980. Therefore the

amount of \$56,000 earmarked for that purpose against 1978-1979 appropriations will be surrendered in the context of the final performance report for the biennium 1978-1979. No provision for the holding of the seminar has been made in the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1980-1981.

(e) <u>Paragraph 22</u>: <u>Undertaking of a study in 1981 on the links between</u> <u>the struggle against racism and the struggle for self-determination</u> <u>in southern Africa</u>

Provision for the undertaking of this study has already been made in the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1980-1981.

4. Should the General Assembly adopt the draft resolution contained in document A/C.3/34/L.9, this would give rise to expenditures estimated at \$421,300.

5. Since in the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1980-1981 provision has already been made for a total of \$67,000, the additional resources required for the implementation of the resolution would amount to \$354,300. Therefore, an additional appropriation of \$354,300 is requested under section 23, Human Rights, of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1980-1981.

6. The related conference servicing costs, calculated on a full-cost basis would amount to \$705,500. They are shown in detail in the annex to the present document. No additional appropriation is being requested at present in connexion with these costs pending the review of actual requirements in the context of the consolidated statement on total conference servicing requirements to be submitted towards the end of the current General Assembly session.
