SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in documents S/15560 of 11 January 1983, S/15560/Add.8 of 3 March 1983, S/15560/Add.12 of 31 March 1983, S/15560/Add.19 of 20 May 1983 and S/15560/Add.31 of 15 August 1983.

During the week ending 13 August 1983, the Security Council took action on the following items:

Letter dated 2 August 1983 from the Permanent Representative of Chad to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council (see S/15560/Add.31)

The Security Council continued its consideration of the item at its 2463rd and 2465th meetings, held on 11 and 12 August 1983. In the course of the meetings, in addition to the representatives invited previously, the President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Benin, Egypt, Guinea, the Islamic Republic of Iran, the Ivory Coast, Kenya, Liberia, the Niger, Senegal, the Sudan and the United Republic of Cameroon, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

Letter dated 8 August 1983 from the Chargé d'Affaires a.i. of the Permanent Mission of the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council

In a letter dated 8 August 1983 addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/15914), the representative of the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, referring to his letter of 6 August (S/15912), requested that the Security Council be convened as a matter of urgency to consider the situation and put

an end to the acts of provocation and hostility perpetrated by the United States of America, <u>inter alia</u>, against the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya.

The Security Council included the item in its agenda without objection at its 2464th meeting, held on 11 August, and continued the discussion at its 2466th meeting, held on 12 August. In the course of the meetings, the President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Afghanistan, Cuba, Democratic Yemen, the Islamic Republic of Iran, the Lao People's Democratic Republic, the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, the Sudan, the Syrian Arab Republic and Viet Nam, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.
