FOR THE GOVERNMENT OF THE POPULAR REPUBLIC OF ALBANIA, TO THE
SECRETARY-GENERAL, DATED 7 DECEMBER 1946

Sir,

I have the honour to inform you that I have taken cognisance of the letter and memorandum, dated 3 December, 1946, submitted to you by the Deputy Head of the Greek delegation on the subject of the situation in Northern Greece.

Seeing that Albania is one of the countries directly referred to in the aforesaid letter and memorandum, I have the honour to request you to permit the delegation of the Government of the Popular Republic of Albania to attend and speak at the meeting of the Security Council when the questions raised by the Greek delegation are discussed.
