REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE
SECURITY COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE REPRESENTATIVE
OF BELGIUM ON THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to Rule 15 of the Provisional Rules of Procedure of the Security Council, I wish to report that I have received a letter dated 7 December 1946 signed by His Excellency Paul-Henri Spaak, Minister for Foreign Affairs of Belgium, designating His Excellency Fernand van Langenhove, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary, as Representative of Belgium on the Security Council.

By a further letter dated 14 December 1946, Mr. Spaak stated that Mr. van Langenhove would be unable to return to New York until the middle of January 1947 and that His Excellency Baron Silvercruyts, Ambassador of Belgium in Washington, will replace Mr. van Langenhove on the Security Council until his return.

In my opinion, these credentials are in order.
