CABLEGRAM FROM THE PRIME MINISTER AND MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF INDIA
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL DATED
9 JANUARY 1948

Your Excellency's telegram dated the 6th of January reached me only yesterday (8 January 1948). In the memorandum which has already been submitted to the Security Council on our behalf there is sufficient evidence, both of our devotion to the principles of the Charter and the patience with which, in the interests of peace, we have suffered and endured provocation and aggression. The Council should therefore need no assurance from the Government of India that they would take no measure contrary to the Charter.

I take this opportunity to present to your Excellency the assurance of my high consideration.
