LETTER FROM THE FERMAMENT REFRESENTATIVE OF GREECE TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-CENERAL DATED 2 JANUARY 19'7

New York, 2 January 1947

I have the honour to request you kindly to bring to the notice of the Members of the Commission of Investigation, set up by the resolution of the Security Council of the 19th ult., that without any kind of prior notice and without being forced by atmospheric conditions to do so, foreign aircraft have started systematically to fly over Greek territory, particularly at night, especially in the following districts:

- (a) north of Alexandropolis,
- (b) east of Kaimakchalan, and
- (c) round Mount Paikon.

The obvious purpose of these flights is to supply lawless bands and should they be continued, the Greek authorities will find themselves obliged to adopt the appropriate measures provided under international law.
