The representative of Indonesia made a statement to register the strong concern that the trend towards relaxing control on illicit drugs, which was in contravention of the letter and spirit of the international drug control conventions, had potential adverse repercussions for drugs under international control. He stressed the importance of guaranteeing the integrity of the entire international drug control regime, as stated by the Group of 77 and China.
