

REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON THE CREDENTIALS OF
REPRESENTATIVES TO THE SECURITY
COUNCIL FOR THE DISCUSSION OF THE GREEK QUESTION

In accordance with Rule 15 of the Provisional Rules of Procedure of the Security Council, I have the honour to submit the following report on the credentials of representatives of States which have been invited to participate in the discussion of the Greek Question.

- Albania Colonel Nesti Kerenxhi, Albanian Liaison Representative to the Commission of Investigation Concerning Greek Frontier Incidents, appointed by cablegram dated 13 May 1947, from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Albania.
- Bulgaria Dr. N. Mevorah, Minister Plenipotentiary, assisted by Mr. Athanassov, Interim Bulgarian Political Representative to the United States, appointed by cablegram dated 9 June 1947, from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Bulgaria.
- Greece His Excellency Mr. Constantine Tsaldaris, Minister for Foreign Affairs of Greece, and as alternate representative, His Excellency Mr. V. Dandramis, Permanent Representative of Greece to the United Nations, appointed by letter dated 12 December 1946 from the Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs of Greece.
- Yugoslavia Dr. Joze Viliban, Permanent Representative of Yugoslavia to the United Nations and as deputy representative Mr. Josip Gjergja, Minister Plenipotentiary, appointed by cablegram dated 21 June 1947 from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Yugoslavia.
