DRAFT RESOLUTION ON THE INDONESIAN QUESTION SUBMITTED BY THE DELEGATIONS
OF COLOMBIA, SYRIA AND THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AT THE 389th
OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

THE SECURITY COUNCIL,

NOTING with concern the resumption of hostilities in Indonesia, and;

HAVING taken note of the reports of the Committee of Good Offices;

CONSIDERS such resumption of hostilities to be in conflict with the
resolution adopted by the Security Council at its 171st meeting of
1 August 1947;

CALLS upon the parties

(a) to cease hostilities forthwith; and

(b) immediately to withdraw their armed forces to their respective
sides of the demilitarized zones established under the Truce
Agreement of 17 January 1948;

INSTRUCTS the Committee of Good Offices to report to the Security Council
fully and urgently by telegraph on the events which have transpired in
Indonesia since 12 December 1948, assessing the responsibility for the
outbreak of hostilities.
