CABLEGRAM DATED 12 AUGUST 1948 FROM THE UNITED NATIONS MEDIATOR TO
THE SECRETARY-GENERAL CONCERNING REFUGEES AND DISPLACED PERSONS

For President Security Council:

In your letter of 3 August you requested me to supply, as soon as possible, any information I might possess on all or some of four questions concerning Arab and Jewish refugees. I have already supplied information concerning questions B and C in my telegram of 8 August to the Secretary-General. As regards D, my point of view as Mediator, entrusted with the supervision of the Truce, is that admission to Palestine of Jewish refugees detained on Cyprus must be governed by general rules in force concerning the observation of the Truce particularly regarding non-admission of fighting personnel and conditions for the admission of men of military age.
