CABLE DATED 13 AUGUST 1948 SENT TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL BY THE UNITED NATIONS MEDIATOR TRANSMITTING THE REPLY OF THE EGYPTIAN GOVERNMENT TO THE TELEGRAM (S/954) SENT TO IT ON 6 AUGUST 1948 BY THE UNITED NATIONS MEDIATOR

With reference to the letter dated 11 August sent to the mediator by the Egyptian Ministry for Foreign Affairs:

"I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your Excellency's telegram of the 7th of this month transmitting to the Royal Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Egyptian Government the text of a note dated the 6th of this month from the Provisional Government of the so-called State of Israel offering to begin direct peace negotiations with the Arab States in order to put an end to the state of war said to exist between it and those States.

"In this regard it is needless to recall that the Security Council, in its two resolutions dated 29 May and 15 July last, expressly entrusted your Excellency as United Nations Mediator for Falestine with the mission of finding a just and peaceful solution to the Falestinian problem and that the Arab States, who accepted the cease-fire order only out of respect for the said resolutions, are still awaiting that solution.

"It is obvious on the other hand that the Zionist offer transmitted through your Excellency is aimed only at forcing the . hand of the Arabs and at consolidating a <u>de facto</u> situation which vain attempts are being made to stabilize, and which is the result of terrorization, persecution and complete disregard of the rights and the desires of the Arabs who nevertheless constitute an enormous majority of the population of Palestine - a state of affairs which has forced hundreds of thousands of Palestinian Arabs into exile under atrocious conditions, while other persons not natives of the country are coming there to establish themselves in their place and stead.

"Your Excellency is surely aware that the Arab States, whose military intervention in Palestine was aimed only at re-establishing order and security and putting an end to the crimes of all kinds that the Zionist terrorist bands have committed and are continuing to commit, have never accorded <u>de facto</u> or <u>de jure</u> recognition to the so-called State of Israel created by such Zionist terrorist bands and is therefore unable to accept the claim of this so-called State to represent in discussions or negotiations any part of Palestine whatever.

"The Egyptian Government therefore feels that no reply is necessary to the Zionist offer that your Excellency has just transmitted to it."
