
LETTER DATED 24 JANUARY 1949 FROM THE SECRETARY GENERAL OF THE ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN STATES TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE UNITED NATIONS TRANSMITTING THE TEXT OF THE INTER-AMERICAN TREATY OF RECIPROCAL ASSISTANCE

My dear Mr. Secretary-General:

In connection with the letter dated 15 December 1948 and the telegram dated 24 December 1948, both from the Chairman of the Council of the Organization of American States, on the resolutions adopted by that Council concerning Costa Rica and Nicaragua and reproduced as Security Council documents S/1171 and S/1172, I have the honour of sending you herewith twenty-five copies (*) of the Inter-American Treaty of Reciprocal Assistance which came into effect on 3 December 1948 and was registered with the Secretariat of the United Nations on 20 December 1948.

I would appreciate that, in order to comply with Article 54 of the United Nations Charter, you transmit these copies to the Security Council for its information.
