CABLEGRAM DATED 26 MARCH 1949 FROM THE UNITED NATIONS COMMISSION FOR INDONESIA TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TRANSMITTING A REPORT ON ALLEGED DAMAGE IN THE CITY OF JOGJAKARTA

For President of Security Council:

The Commission acknowledges receipt of a telegrem dated 23 March 1949 from the President of the Security Council to the Chairman of the Commission requesting a report on alleged damage in the city of Jogjakarta. On the basis of information available to it from its military observers, and from its deputy representatives who visited Jogj/karta on 21 March, the Commission has the honour to report:

- (1) There is no serious damage to the city of Jogjakarta which would interfere in any way with the re-establishment of the Republican government in Jogjakarta;
- (2) however, lack of materials and equipment, part of which has been removed or destroyed since 18 December 1948, will seriously hamper an effective functioning of the Republican administration. It will therefore be necessary for the Netherlands authorities to furnish necessary facilities as anticipated in paragraph 2 of the operative part of the Sccurity Council's resolution of 28 January 1949.
