LETTER DATED 16 AUGUST 1949 FROM THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE ON THE ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

16 August 1949

I have the honour to inform you that during the discussion of the application of Nepal for membership in the United Nations at its 33rd meeting on 15 August 1949, the Committee adopted by nine votes to two the following resolution:

"The Committee on the Admission of New Members has not yet (16 August 1949) been able to reach a conclusion regarding the application of Nepal.

"In this connection the Committee decided that the time limit set forth in Rule 59 should not, in its opinion, constitute an objection to the application of Nepal being considered as soon as possible by the Security Council and by the General Assembly. The Committee will meet again on this application and submit its report to the Council at an early date.

"The Committee draws the attention of the Council to the last paragraph of Rule 60 and suggests that the application of Nepal be considered by the Security Council under this paragraph of its Rules of Procedure."
