

Letter dated 14 August 2002 from the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1373 (2001) concerning counter-terrorism addressed to the President of the Security Council

I refer to my letters dated 28 December 2001 and 18 June 2002 (S/2001/1324 and Add.1) transmitting a report from the Cook Islands submitted to the Counter-Terrorism Committee pursuant to paragraph 6 of resolution 1373 (2001).

The Counter-Terrorism Committee has considered the report carefully with the assistance of its experts, and has written to the Deputy Prime Minister of the Cook Islands to set out its preliminary comments. The Cook Islands has been requested to provide a response in the form of a supplementary report by 20 August 2002.
