LETTER DATED 3 DECEMBER 1948 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF EGYPT  
TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL REQUESTING CONVOCAION OF  
THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Paris, 3 December 1948

I have the honour to refer to my letter dated 1 December 1948  
in which I requested the inclusion, in the Security Council's agenda of  
2 December 1948, of the urgent question of the implementation of the  
Council's decision of 4 November 1948.

I hope your Excellency shares my belief that, after the lapse of one  
month, the Council's Committee appointed by the above-mentioned decision may  
now be in a position to make the necessary report to the Council.

The failure to implement the Council's decision of 4 November 1948  
undermines the efforts for any ultimate peaceful settlement in Palestine,  
and is at the same time most prejudicial to the military and political  
equilibrium which the said decision aimed to achieve.

I, therefore, beg to renew my request that a meeting of the Security  
Council be called as soon as possible to discuss this matter.
