Enclosed letter to the Chairman of the Commission

In your letter dated 22 November 1948 to the President of the
Security Council concerning the situation in Kashmir, you said: "In
an effort to obtain specific information on the present military situation,
the Commission is in communication with the Secretary-General regarding
the appointment of a Military Adviser who would be dispatched to the
Indian sub-Continent as soon as practicable and keep the Commission
currently informed". My Government have informed me that they have no
objection to the United Nations appointing a Military Adviser to the
Commission to be sent to India.
