Letter dated 3 September 2002 from the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1373 (2001) concerning counter-terrorism addressed to the President of the Security Council

I refer to my letter of 26 February 2002 (S/2002/203) transmitting a report from Madagascar submitted to the Counter-Terrorism Committee pursuant to paragraph 6 of resolution 1373 (2001).

The Counter-Terrorism Committee has considered the report carefully with the assistance of its experts and has written to the Permanent Representative of Madagascar to the United Nations to set out its preliminary comments. Madagascar has been requested to provide a response in the form of a supplementary report by 25 November 2002.
