#### **Proposed amendment to Article 18**

### **Transmitted by the Government of Italy**

Article 18, paragraphs 4 and 5, amend to read:

"4. If an objection to the proposed amendment is stated **or**, **in the case of amendment referring to the annexes to this Agreement, at least three objections are stated** in accordance with the terms of paragraphs 2 and 3 of this article, the amendment shall be deemed not to have been accepted and shall be of no effect.

5. If no objection to the proposed amendment has been stated or, **in the case of amendment referring to the annexes to this Agreement, less than three objections have been stated** in accordance with paragraphs 2 and 3 of this article, the amendment shall be deemed to have been accepted on the date specified below:

#### JUSTIFICATION

At the 56<sup>th</sup> session of WP.11 held in November 2000 the representative from Italy said that he would transmit a proposal to amend the Agreement in order to make distinction between technical amendments relating to the annexes and the amendments concerning the articles of the Agreement.
