WITH REFERENCE YOUR TELEGRAMS 46, 47 AND 48 I HAVE THE HONOUR TO
INFORM YOUR EXCELLENCY THAT "THE GOVERNMENT OF AFGHANISTAN BEING
ALWAYS AGAINST AGGRESSION CONFIRMS THE RESOLUTIONS OF THE SECURITY
COUNCIL ADOPTED ON THE 25TH AND 27TH JUNE, BUT DUE TO EXISTING
ANXIETY ABOUT THE UNSETTLED POSITION IN PAKISTAN WISHES TO BE
EXCUSED OF GIVING ANY HELP TO KOREAN REPUBLIC".
