CABLEGRAM DATED 28 JUNE 1950 FROM THE UNITED NATIONS COMMISSION
ON KOREA TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TRANSMITTING THE TEXT OF A
RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSION ON 28 JUNE 1950

"COMMISSION TODAY AT CAMP HAKATA, KYUSHU, JAPAN, UNANIMOUSLY ADOPTED
THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION: 'COMMISSION PURSUANT TO ITS DECISION ON
27 JUNE 1950 TO HOLD ITSELF READY TO RETURN TO KOREA SUBJECT TO
DEVELOPMENTS AND HAVING BEEN INFORMED BY GHQ, SUPREME COMMANDER
ALLIED POWERS ON 28 JUNE 1950 THAT IT IS POSSIBLE AND FEASIBLE
FOR THE COMMISSION TO RETURN TO PUSAN IN SOUTHERN KOREA, DECIDES
TO SEND IMMEDIATELY AN ADVANCE PARTY TO PUSAN TO MAKE SUCH
PREPARATORY ARRANGEMENTS AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO ENABLE COMMISSION
TO RESUME ITS FUNCTIONS IN KOREA'. ADVANCE PARTY WILL CONSIST OF
CHAIRMAN LIU, RAPporteur JAMIESON, KONDAPI, GAILLARD AND TWO UNITED
NATIONS FIELD OBSERVERS".
