CABLEGRAM DATED 29 JUNE 1950 FROM THE MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF
TURKEY ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL CONCERNING THE
SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION ADOPTED ON 27 JUNE 1950
(S/1511)

With reference to your telegram number 8755 of 28 June, I have the honour to inform you that the Government of the Turkish Republic regards the steps taken by the United Nations [Security] Council with a view to putting an end to the tragic situation existing in Korea as the proper expression of a salutary decision to restore peace and to safeguard the sovereign rights of a State which has just been the object of an unprovoked attack. Such a decision, constituting the most certain guarantee of the independence of the peaceful nations, will certainly have the effect of strengthening the confidence of the anxious peoples in world security. It is with this conviction that, in reply to the recommendation you communicated to it on behalf of the Council, my Government declares that it is ready to execute loyally and in complete conformity with the provisions of the Charter the undertakings which Turkey has assumed as a Member of the United Nations
