CABLEGRAM DATED 30 JUNE 1950 FROM THE AUSTRALIAN DEPARTMENT OF EXTERNAL
AFFAIRS TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL CONCERNING THE SECURITY COUNCIL
RESOLUTION OF 27 JUNE 1950 (S/1511)

The Commonwealth Government in further response to the resolution of the Security Council has decided to place at the service of the United Nations through the American authorities the RAAF fighter squadron now stationed in Japan. The United Nations having decided to support the Republic of Korea, the Commonwealth Government as a signatory of the Charter is determined to honour its obligations to do what it can to support the Security Council's decision. The Secretary-General of the United Nations, the Government of the United States of America and the Governments of the United Kingdom and the other British Commonwealth countries are being advised accordingly. Meanwhile the plans for the return of the British Commonwealth Occupation Forces to Australia are to be held in abeyance.
