SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION OF 27 JUNE 1950

IN REPLY YOUR CABLE REGARDING RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE SECURITY COUNCIL
AT ITS 474TH MEETING ON 27 JUNE I HAVE THE HONOUR TO INFORM YOU ON BEHALF OF
MY GOVERNMENT THAT WE ARE PREPARED TO GIVE OUR ASSISTANCE AS FAR AS LIES WITHIN
OUR POWER BUT CAN DO LITTLE OR NOTHING IN VIEW OF THE FACT THAT OUR
CONSTITUTION FORBIDS US AN ARMY AND THAT OUR ECONOMY IS VERY LIMITED. WE
ASSURE YOU OF OUR MORAL SOLIDARITY AND OF OUR SUPPORT FOR THE SECURITY COUNCIL
DECISIONS.
