CABLEGRAM DATED 2 JULY 1950 FROM THE MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF  
COLOMBIA ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL CONCERNING SECURITY  
COUNCIL RESOLUTION OF 27 JUNE 1950 (S/1511)

HAVE HONOUR TO ACKNOWLEDGE YOUR EXCELLENCY'S CABLES NOS. 11 AND 12 INFORMING THIS MINISTRY OF RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY SECURITY COUNCIL AT ITS 474TH MEETING ON 27 JUNE 1950 ON ARMED ATTACK BY NORTH KOREAN GOVERNMENT AND ALSO DRAWING MY GOVERNMENT'S ATTENTION TO THIS DECISION AND REQUESTING INFORMATION REGARDING ATTITUDE OF COLOMBIA AND PARTICULARLY TYPE OF ASSISTANCE IT COULD FURNISH IN PRESENT EMERGENCY. IN THANKING YOUR EXCELLENCY WARMLY FOR ABOVE-MENTIONED MESSAGES I HAVE HONOUR TO REAFFIRM COLOMBIA'S SENTIMENTS OF SOLIDARITY AND SUPPORT IN REGARD TO EXPEDIENCY OF MEASURES DECIDED BY UNITED NATIONS SECURITY COUNCIL. AS REGARDS POSSIBLE ASSISTANCE WHICH COLOMBIA COULD FURNISH I HAVE PLEASURE IN INFORMING YOUR EXCELLENCY THAT IT WILL DEPEND ON COURSE OF EVENTS AND MEANS AVAILABLE COLOMBIA. I TAKE OPPORTUNITY TO REPEAT TO YOUR EXCELLENCY ASSURANCES OF HIGH CONSIDERATION.
