CABLEGRAM DATED 2 JULY 1950 FROM THE VICE-MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS
OF THE GOVERNMENT OF ETHIOPIA ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL
CONCERNING THE SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION OF 27 JUNE 1950
(S/1511)

I HAVE HONOUR REFER TO YOUR TELEGRAM NO. 86 OF JUNE 29 CONCERNING SECURITY COUNCIL RECOMMENDATION MEMBER NATIONS FURNISH AS MAY BE NECESSARY REPEL ARMED ATTACK ON REPUBLIC OF KOREA AND TO RESTORE INTERNATIONAL PEACE AND SECURITY IN THE AREA. IMPERIAL ETHIOPIAN GOVERNMENT FULLY APPROVES AND ACCEPTS THIS SECURITY COUNCIL RECOMMENDATION. GOVERNMENT IS WITHDRAWING ALL ASSISTANCE TO THE REGIME IGNORING RECOMMENDATION AND ENDORSES THE EFFORTS OF MEMBER NATIONS IN BETTER IMMEDIATE POSITION RENDER ASSISTANCE TO REPUBLIC OF KOREA IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECURITY COUNCIL RECOMMENDATION. IMPERIAL ETHIOPIAN GOVERNMENT REAFFIRMS ITS UNSWERVING LOYALTY TO PRINCIPLE OF COLLECTIVE SECURITY AND ITS PROMPT APPLICATION TO LIMIT AND CONTROL AGGRESSION AND TO SECURE AND MAINTAIN INTERNATIONAL CONDITIONS THAT WILL PERMIT THE SELF DETERMINATION OF ALL PEOPLES.
