LETTER FROM UNITED STATES DEPUTY REPRESENTATIVE ON THE SECURITY COUNCIL
DATED 19 DECEMBER 1948 TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL
REQUESTING CONVOCAATION OF COUNCIL'S EMERGENCY MEETING

Reports have come to my Government emanating from Netherlands Government and Indonesian Republican sources that military operations commenced on Saturday, December 18, in Indonesia.

Under the instructions of my Government, I therefore request an emergency meeting of the Security Council further to consider the Indonesian Question in the light of these recent events and of the concluding paragraph (7) of the last Report of the Committee of Good Offices (S/1117). My Government feels that the Security Council should meet at the earliest possible moment which I would take to be Monday, December 20.

The Representative of Australia has requested me to associate his Government with this request.
