Reply of Panama:

29 June 1950

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your cable of 25 June 1950 in which you forwarded to this Ministry text of the resolution adopted by the Security Council at its 473rd meeting held on that date, regarding the measures recommended to Member States in order to put a stop to the conflict which has arisen as a result of the armed attack on the Republic of Korea by North Korean forces.
