CABLEGRAM DATED 7 JULY 1950 FROM THE SECRETARY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF  
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PHILIPPINES TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL  
CONCERNING THE SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION OF 27 JUNE  
1950 (S/1511)

IN REPLY TO YOUR RADIOGRAM INVITING ATTENTION OF THIS GOVERNMENT TO THE  
RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE SECURITY COUNCIL AT ITS FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY FOURTH  
MEETING ON 27 JUNE 1950 I HAVE THE HONOR TO INFORM YOU THAT THE PHILIPPINE  
GOVERNMENT AS A MEMBER OF THE UNITED NATIONS WILL COMPLY WITH ITS OBLIGATIONS  
UNDER THE CHARTER AND PLEDGE ITS MORAL SUPPORT TO THE EFFORTS OF THE  
UNITED NATIONS TO SAFEGUARD THE INTEGRITY OF THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH KOREA  
AND TO RESTORE INTERNATIONAL PEACE AND SECURITY IN THE AREA. TO THIS END,  
MY GOVERNMENT IS ALSO PREPARED TO CONTRIBUTE, IF CALLED UPON, SUCH AMOUNTS OF  
COPRA, COCONUT OIL, SOAP, RICE, AND ANTI CHOLERA, TYPHOID, DYSENTERY VACCINES;  
ALSO SMALLPOX VIRUS THAT MAY HELP FACILITATE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE  
RESOLUTION.
