CABLEGRAM DATED 20 JULY 1950 FROM THE MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF PERU TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL IN REPLY TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL'S CABLEGRAM OF 14 JULY 1950 CONCERNING THE SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTIONS OF 25 AND 27 JUNE, AND 7 JULY 1950 (S/1501, S/1511, S/1583)

I HAVE THE HONOUR TO REPLY TO YOUR CABLEGRAM OF 14 JULY IN WHICH RECALLING THAT PERU HAD STATED THAT IT WAS PREPARED TO ACT IN CONCERT WITH OTHER MEMBERS TO GIVE EFFECT TO THE RESOLUTIONS OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL YOU INFORM ME THAT THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES WHICH HAD RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE UNIFIED COMMAND IS PREPARED TO ENTER INTO DIRECT CONSULTATIONS TO COORDINATE ASSISTANCE WITHIN A GENERAL PLAN. IN REPLY I HAVE PLEASURE IN INFORMING YOU THAT PERU HAS TAKEN THE REQUISITE STEPS TO PROHIBIT ANY WAR-LIKE AND ECONOMIC ASSISTANCE TO AND ANY FINANCIAL COMMERCIAL POSTAL AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS RELATIONS WITH NORTH KOREA AND THE TERRITORIES OCCUPIED BY ITS ARMED FORCES. THE PERUVIAN GOVERNMENT IS ALSO GIVING SYMPATHETIC CONSIDERATION TO FURNISHING ASSISTANCE IN THE CONFLICT AND IS READY TO ENTER INTO CONSULTATION REGARDING COORDINATION OF SUCH ASSISTANCE WITH THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES WHICH HAS BEEN ENTRUSTED WITH RESPONSIBILITY UNIFIED COMMAND.
