CABLEGRAM DATED 9 JULY FROM THE MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS
OF YEMEN TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL CONCERNING THE SECURITY
COUNCIL RESOLUTION OF 27 JUNE 1950 (S/1511)

HAVE RECEIVED YOUR CABLE OF 29 JUNE 1950 CONCERNING THE KOREA QUESTION. HIS MAJESTY'S GOVERNMENT EXPRESSES ITS REGRET AT THIS DEVELOPMENT IN THE INTERNATIONAL SITUATION AND EXPRESSES ALSO ITS DEVOTION TO PEACE AND STABILITY IN THE WORLD IN ACCORDANCE WITH ITS TRADITIONS. HIS MAJESTY'S GOVERNMENT CONDEMNS ANY ATTACK AGAINST ANY STATE AND ANY INTERFERENCE IN ITS OWN AFFAIRS. IT APPROVES THE UNITED NATIONS CHARTER IN THE HOPE THAT THERE WILL BE NO RECOURSE TO THE USE OF FORCE FOR THE ACHIEVEMENT OF AMBITIONS ON ANY OCCASION OR AT ANY TIME. THE YEMEN WILL APPROVE THIS GENERAL POLICY WITHIN THE LIMITS OF ITS FRONTIERS. HIS MAJESTY'S GOVERNMENT HOPES THAT THERE WILL BE NO DESPAIR AND THAT ALL ACTION WILL BE GUIDED BY WISDOM SO AS TO BANISH THE SPECTRE OF WAR WHICH WILL SPREAD MISFORTUNE THROUGHOUT THE WORLD.
