ECUADOR TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL
IN REPLY TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL'S CABLEGRAM OF 14 JULY 1950
(S/1619) CONCERNING THE SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTIONS
OF 25 AND 27 JUNE AND 7 JULY 1950 (S/1501, S/1511, S/1582)

REFERENCE YOUR CABLEGRAM OF 14 JULY IN WHICH YOU ASK ABOUT THE ASSISTANCE
ECUADOR IS PREPARED TO RENDER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RESOLUTION OF 27 JUNE TO
REPEL THE ATTACK UPON THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA I HAVE PLEASURE IN INFORMING YOU
THAT ECUADOR IN ITS FIRM DESIRE TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE RE-ESTABLISHMENT OF
INTERNATIONAL ORDER OFFERS ECONOMIC SUPPORT WITHIN ITS MEANS POSSIBLY IN THE
FORM OF THE DISPATCH OF CERTAIN STRATEGIC MATERIALS AND MEDICINAL SUBSTANCES
ACCORDING TO AN AGREEMENT THAT WOULD HAVE TO BE NEGOTIATED WITH THE UNIFIED
COMMAND. WITH REGARD TO CONTRIBUTION OF ARMED FORCES ECUADOR DOES NOT FEEL IT
CAN MAKE ANY OFFER SINCE THE ONLY FORCES AT ITS DISPOSAL ARE THOSE NEEDED FOR
NATIONAL SECURITY.
