REPORT DATED 22 DECEMBER 1948 FROM THE ASSISTANT SECRETARY-GENERAL
TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS
OF THE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNITED KINGDOM

Pursuant to rule 15 of the Provisional Rules of Procedure of the Security Council, I wish to report that I have received a letter dated 21 December 1948, from the Ambassador of the United Kingdom in Paris, transmitting a message from the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs stating that Mr. M.E. Dening, Assistant Under Secretary of State, has been authorized to represent the United Kingdom on the Security Council, in the absence of Sir A. Cadogan, Permanent Representative on the Security Council. In my opinion, this letter constitutes adequate provisional credentials.
