CABLEGRAM DATED 10 AUGUST 1950 FROM THE MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF ISRAEL ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL IN REPLY TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL'S CABLEGRAM OF 14 JULY 1950 (S/1619) CONCERNING THE SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTIONS OF 25 AND 27 JUNE, AND 7 JULY 1950 (S/1501, S/1511, S/1588)

WITH FURTHER REFERENCE MY CABLE THIRD AUGUST HAVE HONOUR INFORM YOU THAT AT THIS STAGE ISRAEL COULD SUPPLY, AT THREE TO FOUR WEEKS NOTICE, SUBSTANTIAL QUANTITIES FOLLOWING DRUGS TO UNITED NATIONS FORCES IN KOREA: OPIATES, SEDATIVES, SULFADRUGS, PROCAIN, STIMULANTS, DICUMAROL. SHOULD BE GRATEFUL IF YOU WOULD COMMUNICATE THIS OFFER TO UNIFIED COMMAND AND INFORM ME IN DUE COURSE OF ITEMS REQUIRED AND PLACE TO WHICH GOODS SHOULD BE CONSIGNED.
