CARLIGRAM DATED 1.0 AUGUST 1950 FROM THE MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF IRRALL ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL IN REPLY TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL'S CABLECRAM OF 14 JULY 1950 (S/1619) CONCERNING THE SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTIONS OF 25 AND 27 JULY, AND 7 JULY 1950 (S/1501, S/1511, S/1588)

WITH FURTHER REFFRENCE MY CABLE TEURD AUGUST HAVE HONOUR INFORM YOU THAT AT THIS STAGE ISRAEL COULD SUPPLY, AT THREE TO FOUR WEEKS NOTICE, SUBSTANTIAL QUANTITIES FOLLOWING IRUGS TO UNITED NATIONS FORCES IN KOREA: OPTATES, SEDATIVES, SULFAIRUGS, PROCAIN, STIMULANTS, DICUMAROL. SHOULD BE GRATEFUL IF YOU WOULD COMPUNICATE THIS OFFER TO UNIFIED COMMAND AND INFORM ME IN DUE COURSE OF ITEMS REQUIRED AND PLACE TO WHICH GOODS SHOULD BE CONSIGNED.
