In addition to the activities supported by the regular budget, some of the information and outreach activities of the Department for Disarmament Affairs are supported by the Voluntary Trust Fund for the United Nations Disarmament Information Programme. The available balance that remained in the Fund as at 31 December 2001 amounted to US\$ 844,343. The status of the Fund as at 31 December 2001, in line with the (audited) financial statements for the biennium, is described in the annex to the present document.
- 2. Information activities continue to benefit from the generosity of Member States and private donors. The Department for Disarmament Affairs is grateful for all donations and support for general activities, as well as particular projects. During the period from 1 January 2000 to 31 December 2001, the United Nations received a total of \$235,400 in contributions from the following States: Andorra, Argentina, Finland, Greece, Mexico, Netherlands, Panama and Republic of Korea. In addition, \$100,000 was received from a private donation.
