Paragraphs 9, 10 and 11

The paragraphs *should read*

9. From 1 August 2001 to 31 August 2002, the reports of 12 States parties were received by the Secretary-General: Albania (combined, initial and second periodic reports); Argentina (fifth periodic report); Canada (fifth periodic report); Congo (combined initial, second, third, fourth and fifth periodic reports); Ecuador (combined fourth and fifth periodic reports); France (fifth periodic report) Guatemala (fifth periodic report); Luxembourg (fourth periodic report); Saint Kitts and Nevis (combined initial, second, third and fourth periodic reports); Suriname (combined initial and second periodic reports); and Yemen (fifth periodic report).

10. From 1 August 2001 to 31 August 2002, at its twenty-sixth and twenty-seventh sessions and at the exceptional session authorized by the General Assembly in its resolution 56/229,¹ the Committee considered 31 reports submitted by 26 States parties.

11. As at 31 August 2002, reports submitted by 17 States parties had yet to be considered by the Committee. The Committee will consider the reports of the 8 States parties during its twenty-eighth session, in January 2003. As at 31 August 2002, there were 264 overdue reports, of which 45 were initial reports, 63 were second periodic reports, 56 were third periodic reports, 49 were fourth periodic reports and 51 were fifth periodic reports.
