LETTER DATED 4 AUGUST 1950 FROM THE DEPUTY PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNION OF SOUTH AFRICA ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL IN REPLY TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL'S CABLEGRAM OF 14 JULY 1950 (S/1619) CONCERNING THE SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTIONS OF 25 AND 27 JUNE, AND 7 JULY 1950 (S/1501, S/1511,S/1588)

I have the honour to refer to my letter No.11/21 of 24 July 1950 (S/1625) concerning your appeal to governments to furnish additional effective assistance for Korea and to inform you by direction that the Government of the Union of South Africa have decided to make available a fighter squadron, including both air crews and ground personnel for service with the United Nations forces in Korea. Discussions are being initiated with the Government of the United States of America in regard to the practical implementation of this offer.
