LETTER DATED 31 AUGUST 1950 FROM THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I am sending you 6,211 telegrams and letters which I have received in my capacity as President of the Security Council from various organizations and private individuals in different countries of the world expressing support for the Soviet proposals made in the Security Council for the peaceful settlement of the Korean question and containing protests against the aggression committed by the United States Government in Korea and against the barbarous bombing by the American air force of peaceful towns and populated centres and the shelling of the peaceful population in Korea.

I would ask you to give instructions for these telegrams to be included in the list of letters and telegrams received by the Security Council during August. Please issue this letter as a Security Council document.
